THE BURMA POST OFFICE ACT AMENDING LAW, 1963.

[THE UNION OF BURMA REVOLUTIONARY COUNCIL LAW No. 10 OF 1963]

The Chairman of the Union of Burma Revolutionary Council makes the following Law:-

- 1. (1) This Law may be called the Burma Post Office Act Amending Law, 1963.
 - (2) It shall come into force at once.
- 2. In section 2 of the Burma Post Office Act hereinafter referred to as the said Act,—
 - (a) in clause (d) for the words "His Britannic Majesty's Government or the Government of any British possession or foreign country" the words "the Government of any foreign country" shall be substituted; and
 - (dd), namely:—
 - "(dd) the expression "mail aircraft" means an aircraft as defined in the Burma Aircraft Act, employed for carrying mails pursuant to a contract or continuing arrangement, by the Government of the Union of Burma or the Government of any foreign country;".
- 3. In sub-section (1) of section 10 of the said Act, for the words "the United Kingdom, or with any British possession or foreign country" the words "any foreign country" shall be substituted and for the words "the United Kingdom or such possession or country" the words "such country" shall be substituted.
- 4. In section 15 of the said Act, for the words "the United Kingdom or of any British possession or foreign country" the words "any foreign country" shall be substituted.
- 5. In sub-section (1) of section 46 of the said Act, for the words "the United Kingdom or with any British possession, State in India or Pakistan or the Union of Burma or foreign country" the words "any foreign country" shall be substituted and for the words "the United Kingdom or such possession, State or country" the words "such country" shall be substituted.
