THE MIDWIVES AND NURSES ACT, AMENDING LAW, 1963.

[THE UNION OF BURMA REVOLUTIONARY COUNCIL LAW No. 6 OF 1963.]

The Chairman of the Union of Burma Revolutionary Council makes the following Law:—

- 1. (1) This Law may be called the Midwives and Nurses Act, Amending Law, 1963.
 - (2) It shall come into force at once.
- 2. After section 5 of the Midwives and Nurses Act, the following shall be inserted as section 5A, namely:—
 - "5a. If any midwife or nurse is convicted under section 312,

 Removal of names on conviction under certain sections of the Penal Code,

 Penal Code.

 312a, 312B, 312c, 312D, 313, 314 or section 315 of the Penal Code, the Council shall remove the name of the said midwife or nurse from the register:

Provided that no action under this section shall be taken-

- (a) where an appeal is filed, until the appeal has been finally decided, or
- (b) where no appeal is filed, until the period provided for such appeal has expired."
