

THE YANGON POLICE (AMENDMENT) ACT, 1955.*

**[Act No. XLVI of 1955.]
(The 6th October 1955)**

It is hereby enacted as follows : —

- 1. (1) This Act may be called the Yangon Police (Amendment) Act, 1955.
- (2) It shall come into force on such date as the President of the Union may, by notification, direct.

2. For section 41A of the Yangon Police Act the following *shall be substituted*, namely:—

| <p>“41A(1)</p> <p><i>Punishment for unlicensed use of loudspeaker or sound amplifier.</i></p> | <p>Save as provided by any other law for the time being in force, whoever, without a licence issued by the Commissioner of Police or otherwise than in accordance with such conditions as may from time to time be imposed by him, uses or operates or permits to be used or operated any loudspeaker or sound amplifier shall be liable to a fine which shall not exceed two hundred kyats or to imprisonment not exceeding fifteen days, or to both.</p> |

- (2) Notwithstanding anything contained in the Code of Criminal Procedure an offence under this section shall be cognizable by the Police.”
