THE ESSENTIAL SUPPLIES AND SERVICES ACT AMENDING LAW, 1965.

(The Union of Burma Revolutionary Council Law No. 3 of 1965.)

The Chairman of the Revolutionary Council of the Union of Burma makes the following Law :-

- (1) This Law may be called the Essential Supplies and Services Act Amending Law, 1965.
 - (2) It shall come into force at once.

2. In section 8 of the Essential Supplies and Services Act, 1947 after subsection (4) the following shall be inserted as sub-section (5) namely :-

"(5) Notwithstanding anything contained elsewhere in this Act or in any other law for the time being in force, all things in respect of which an offence punishable under sub-section (1) has been committed may be confiscated by order of such Committee or body of persons as may be empowered by the Government in this behalf. All things confiscated under this sub-section shall be disposed of in accordance with the directions issued by the Government."
