

THE BURMA GENERAL CLAUSES ACT AMENDING LAW, 1965.

[THE UNION OF BURMA REVOLUTIONARY COUNCIL LAW No. 10 OF 1965.]

The Chairman of the Revolutionary Council of the Union of Burma makes the following Law:—

1. (1) This Law may be called the Burma General Clauses Act Amending Law, 1965.

(2) It shall come into force at once.

2. In section 2 of the Burma General Clauses Act, for clause (26) the following shall be substituted as clause (26), namely:

“(26) “Government” or “the Government” shall mean the person “Government” authorized by the Revolutionary Council of the Union of Burma to exercise the executive authority of the Union of Burma.”
