

THE REGISTRATION OF FOREIGNERS (AMENDMENT) ACT, 1956.*

[Act No. XXV OF 1956]
(The 28th September 1956)

It is hereby enacted as follows : —

1. This Act may be called the Registration of Foreigners (Amendment) Act, 1956.

2. In section 2 of the Registration of Foreigners Act, hereinafter referred to as the said Act, for clause (b) thereof, the following shall be substituted as clause (b), namely:—

“(b) ‘prescribed’ means prescribed by the President of the Union or by rules made by the President of the Union.”

3. After section 2 of the said Act, the following shall be inserted as section 2A thereof, namely:—

“2A. Fees may be charged for the issue or the annual renewal of Certificates of Registration or for the supply of duplicate copies of Certificates of Registration lost or destroyed at such rates as may be prescribed.”

4. In section 3 of the said Act,—

(a) the word “and” at the end of clause (f) thereof shall be deleted;

(b) the following shall be inserted as clause (g) thereof namely:—

“(g) for payment of fees by foreigners under section 2A and;” and

(c) the existing clause (g) shall be relettered as clause (h) thereof.
